Perth Montessori School successful in Grant Applications

I am delighted to announce that the School has recently been successful in its application for funding under the Federal Government's 'Building the Education Revolution' program.

As you may be aware, the Federal Government recently announced an allocation of approximately \$14 billion in funds to be allocated to Schools across all sectors in Australia to enable them to either upgrade and maintain their existing facilities and/or build new facilities. One of the major requirements of the application process was the need to apply for funding according to prescriptive guidelines in a very compressed time frame. The School was able to meet those requirements because of the impressive 'above and beyond' effort that was put in by Gary Pears, Narida Collins and John Brown to ensure that we submitted two compliant and highly successful applications. It was a great effort and on behalf of the Board I would like to record deep appreciation for their passionate commitment to the School and its community.

As result of these applications, the School has been granted \$125,000 for immediate repairs and refurbishments around the School and \$2,000,000 for the creation of additional learning spaces within the School. This is an outstanding result for the School, our current students and those who will join our community in future years.

You will begin to see activity associated with the repairs and maintenance grant within a few weeks, work on the new learning spaces will take a bit longer to get organised simply due to scale.
